Utopia

"A utopia is a community or society possessing highly desirable or near perfect qualities. The word was coined by Sir Thomas More in Greek for his 1516 book Utopia, describing a fictional island society in the Atlantic Ocean."

- 1. Imagine that you have been hired to plan and create an "ideal" society.
- a. Give your "perfect" community a name, a system of government, a physical description, and an account of how people spend their days
- b. Think about how that community would change and grow? How does the community use resources and remove wastes?
- c. How do people meet their basic needs for food, water, an shelter?
- d. What are the rules or laws? What happens if someone breaks them? How do people resolve conflicts?

Be prepared to explain your "ideal" society to the class and have a visual to show. Visuals could be a poster, a banner, a keynote, a commercial, a newspaper ad, or a model.
